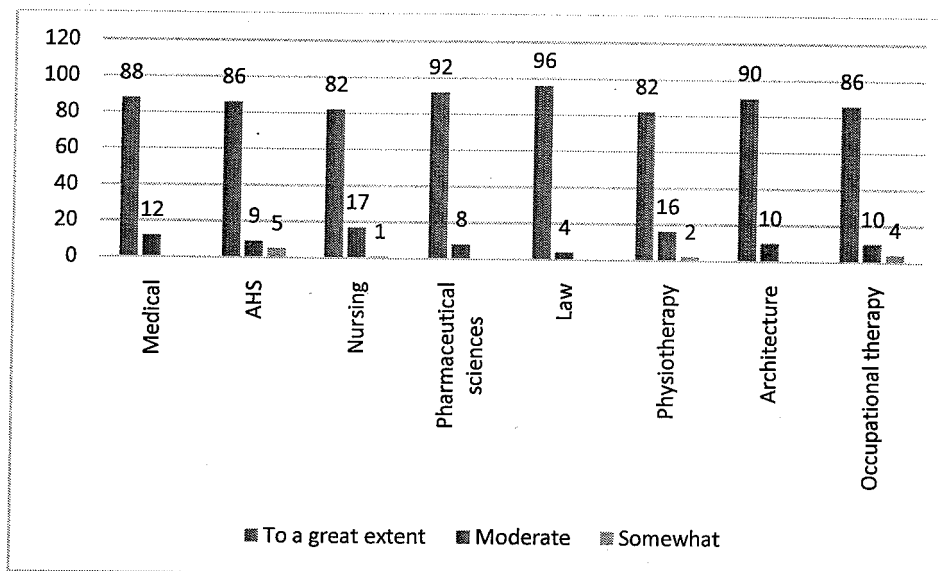

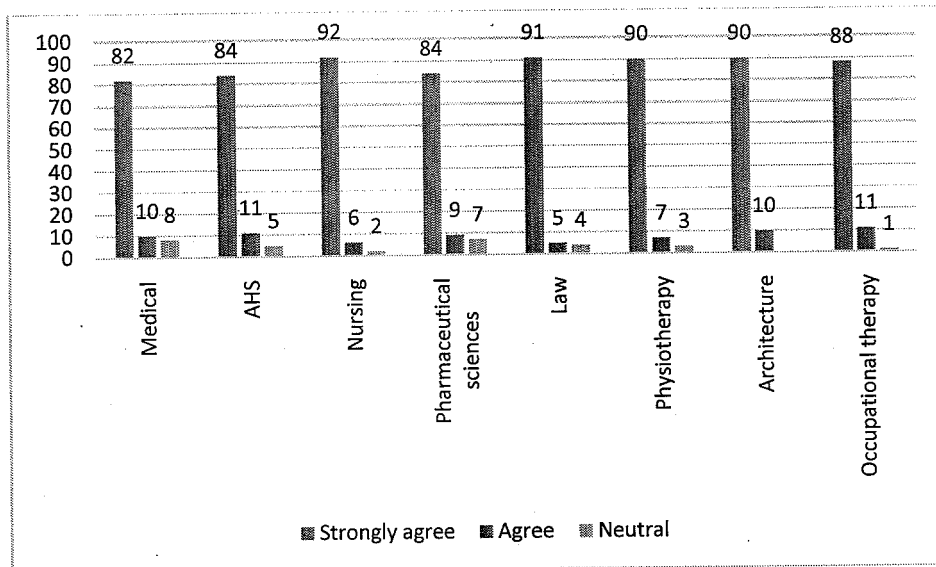

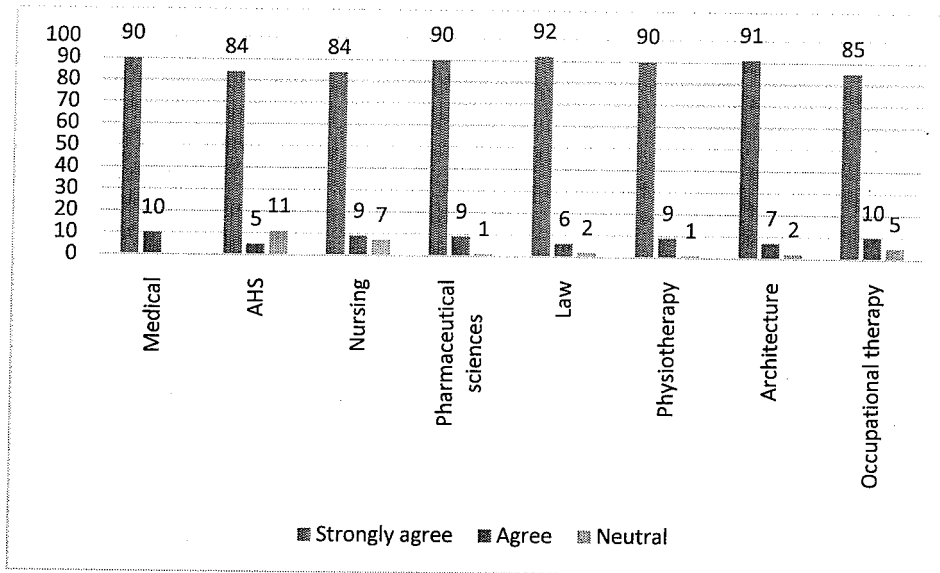
Percentage of teachers who uses ICT tools like LCD projector, Multimedia etc while teaching



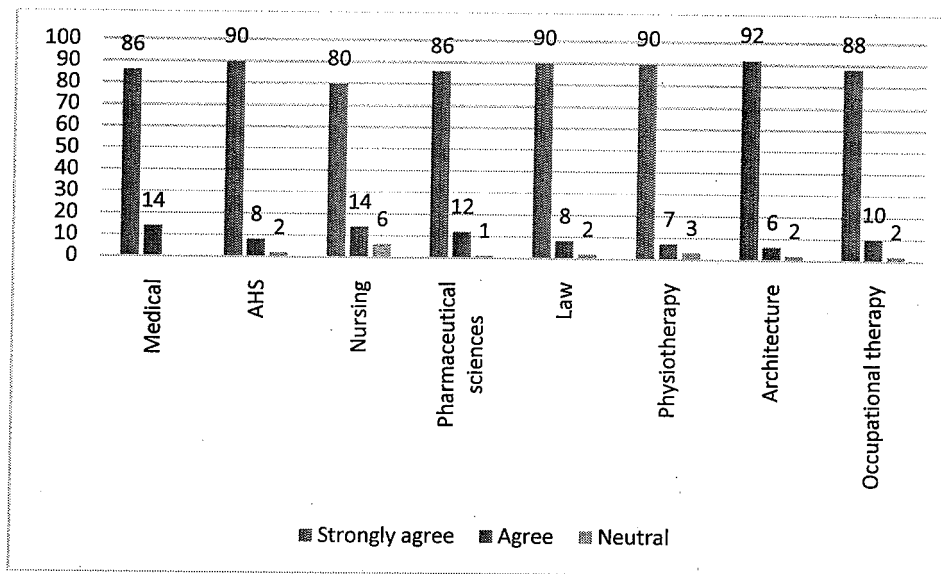
