Report of the event:



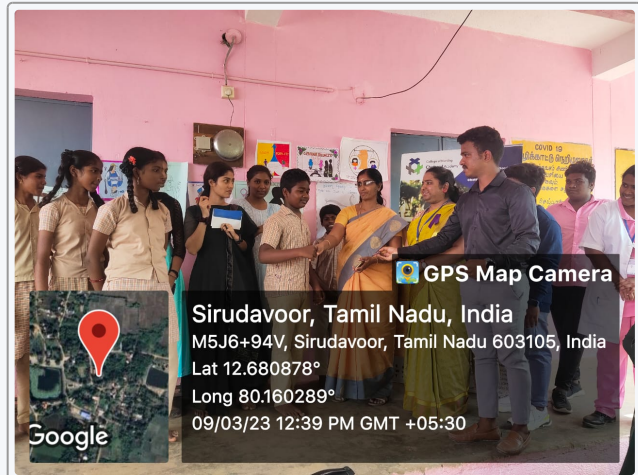
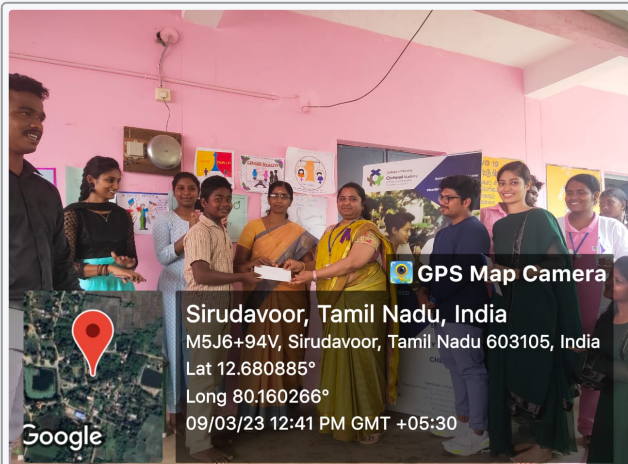
